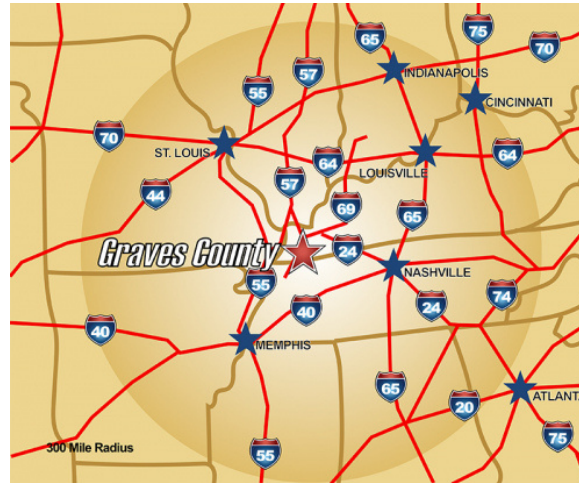

GOURD PATCH ARTS FESTIVAL

Visit Mayfield-Graves County on the third Saturday in September for the Gourd Patch Arts Festival, sponsored by the Mayfield-Graves County Art Guild. Here, Mayfield pays homage to the humble gourd with vendors, artists and crafters, entertainment, concessions, and even a gourd car race.



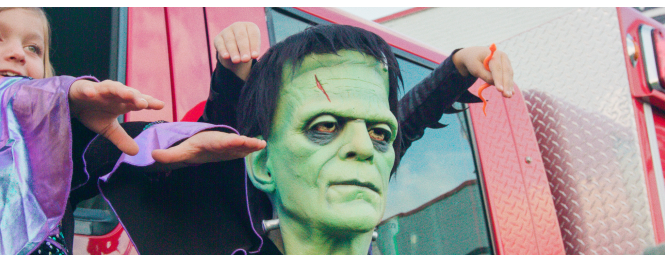
FANCY FARM PICNIC



The Fancy Farm Picnic, named "The World's Largest Picnic" by the Guinness Book of World Records, is held on the first Saturday in August. The "Picnic" is the kick-off political event for the state of Kentucky and includes stump speeches by local, state, and federal officials, barbeque with all the fixings, and games for all ages.

HAUNTED GRAVES FESTIVAL

Mayfield & Graves County really shines during October with our month-long Haunted Graves Festival. Check out A-Maize-ing Farms, the largest corn maze in Kentucky, and Talon Falls Adventure Park, a fall-themed, family-friendly amusement park. We also have terrifying places like Talon Falls Scream Park in Melber and the Industrial Slaughterhouse in Fancy Farm.



Each weekend of October features different events, including a lighted Halloween parade, a spooky 5-K race, a glow-golf scramble, a scary play, multiple trick-or-treat opportunities, fall festivals, and more!

EXPERIENCES

WOOLDRIDGE MONUMENTS

Visit the Wooldridge Monuments in Maplewood Cemetery, known as the "Strange Procession that Never Moves", and featured in the television show, "Ripley's Believe it or Not", and in the book, "Weird Kentucky". Best described as the unusual stone figures of an eccentric aristocrat and soldier, these figures were built from 1892 until 1899. Mr. Wooldridge, his family, friends, and even favorite animals are enshrined here. (611 North 5th St., Mayfield)



CARTWRIGHT GROVE

Cartwright Grove is an 1800's wild west town located at the Mayfield-Graves County Fairgrounds. Themed open house weekends are held throughout the year, including a Haunted Fall Festival the last three weekends in October, and Christmas at the Grove on the first three weekends in December. (Highway 121 & North 17th St., Mayfield)



FANCY FARM VINEYARD & WINERY

The Fancy Farm Vineyard & Winery is a great place to enjoy a variety of locally produced wines in a welcoming atmosphere. Open weekends, they host frequent events like karaoke, trivia, live music, & vendor/craft fairs. (115 Hayden St., Fancy Farm)

ARTS SCENE

The Purchase Players Community Performing Arts Center includes annual season performances by children, teens, and adults. (302 West Water St., Mayfield)



The Mayfield-Graves County Art Guild exhibits original works from local and regional artists, hosts eight shows throughout the year, offers art classes, and is home to a gift shop where you can purchase handcrafted items made by local artists. (Lobby of Regions Bank, 1104 Paris Rd., Mayfield)

OUTDOOR RECREATION

Mayfield & Graves County has many options for outdoor recreation, including six parks, an eight-field baseball complex, a soccer complex, a golf course, & an 8,265-acre national wildlife refuge.

Kess Creek Park includes a disc golf course, a fishing pond, a spray park, walking trails, picnic pavilions, and playground equipment. (201 Locust St., Mayfield)



The Mayfield-Graves County Fairgrounds also is home to harness racing, remote control car racing, vendor & craft shows, Cartwright Grove, and the Purchase District Fair. (Highway 121 & North 17th St., Mayfield)
